Guidelines for using DAV vans

- DAV van passengers are expected to follow certain guidelines, established by the Department of Veterans Affairs and the DAV National Headquarters. These guidelines include the following:
- All riders must be ambulatory (able to board and exit the van without the driver's help).
- The DAV van driver is only allowed to stop the van for rest stops, emergencies, and to pick up and drop off passengers. Passengers should not ask the driver to make side trips to take care of their personal business.
- Passengers are not permitted to smoke, chew tobacco, drink alcohol, use foul language, or bring weapons, drugs, or any illegal substance on the van. Van drivers are not required to provide transportation to any Veteran who is intoxicated, abusive, or who poses a threat to the driver or other passengers.
- Passengers should not do anything to distract the driver.
- Passengers should wear seatbelts at all times. Any passenger who refuses to wear a seatbelt will be denied transportation.
- If a Veteran needs another individual (for example, a caregiver) to ride in the van with them, they need to get authorization from their VA attending physician or VA-certified nurse practitioner.
- Veterans being discharged or granted passes can ride on a DAV van during the van's trip back to its home county only if space is available. The Veteran must be ready to leave when the van leaves the VA medical center.
- Veterans should be dressed and ready to leave for the hospital at the time specified. Drivers can't wait for Veterans who aren't ready to leave at the appointed time.
- Veterans can only bring with them items that they can hold on their lap or store under the seat.
- The DAV van is not an emergency vehicle. The driver may refuse to transport any Veteran who appears to be too ill to ride the van.
- Veterans who use the DAV Transportation Network will not be eligible to receive reimbursement for travel expenses. (M-1, Part 1, Chapter 25, July 8, 1991)

Veterans' Affairs:

- VA Benefits: Assistance with accessing and understanding your VA benefits, including health care, disability compensation, and education benefits.
- Military Records: Help in obtaining or correcting military records, such as DD214s.
- VA Claims: Support with filing or expediting VA claims and appeals.

Assistance with Federal Agencies:

- Social Security: Help with Social Security benefits, including retirement, disability, and survivor benefits.
- Medicare: Assistance with Medicare issues, such as enrollment, coverage disputes, or understanding your options.
- IRS: Guidance on resolving tax issues, obtaining tax refunds, and dealing with the IRS.

Help for Active Duty Service Members:

- Deployment Issues: Assistance with deployment-related concerns or problems with your military service
- Benefits: Help navigating benefits available to active-duty members, including family support programs.

Passport Services:

- Expedited Passport Processing: Assistance with urgent passport requests and renewals.
- Lost Passports: Help with replacing lost or stolen passports.

Washington D.C. Office:

Legislation Tracking: Information on current bills and votes, as well as the representatives positions on key issues.

Policy Inquiries: Answers to questions about federal policy and the legislative process.

Flag Requests: U.S. Flags: Order a U.S. flag flown over the Capital in honor of a special occasion. This service includes a certificate of authenticity.

Capital Tours: Assistance with arranging tours of the U.S. Capital and other federal landmarks.

Policy and Mandates



Day of Mourning:

The Governor is required to proclaim a state-wide day of mourning, during which the state flag shall be flown at half-staff over the state capitol, in the event an armed services member is killed in action or dies as a direct result of injuries sustained from a service-connected, combat-related cause. This also includes a member of a reserve or Tennessee National Guard Unit called into active military duty and stationed outside the United States during hostilities.

Registration of Discharges:

County Registrars are required to register separation document DD-214 (discharges) the servicemember named in the discharge, or to the holder of such discharge. This service is to be provided free of charge.

Unclaimed Property:

Abandoned military medals are held by the State Treasurer until the owner or owner's heirs or beneficiaries can be identified for the return of the medal. The Treasurer may appoint a custodian such as a veterans' organization to hold the abandoned medals. Additional and specific requirement information can be found on the Treasury's website.

False Representation of a Service Member:

As enacted, creates Class B misdemeanor offense of a person falsely representing (conduct, dress, verbally, or in writing) that he or she was or is a member of the United States armed forces with the intent to deceive another into believing such representation. The law shall not apply to wearing the dress of a member of the armed forces if done for the following purposes; Instructional, theatrical, motion picture or entertainment, historical, ceremonial, educational or as a costume.






Veteran Population and Services by Region

State Veterans Service Officers are divided into 4 Regions



Tennessee Treatment Courts VETERANS COURT

Veterans treatment courts are hybrid drug and mental health courts that use the recovery drug court model to serve veterans struggling with addiction, serious mental illness and/or co-occurring disorders. They promote sobriety, recovery and stability through a coordinated response that involves cooperation and collaboration with the traditional partners found in drug and mental health courts, with the addition of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs health care networks, the Veterans' Benefits Administration, volunteer veteran mentors and veterans and veterans' family support organizations. The veterans treatment court model uses volunteer veteran mentors and veterans' family support organizations to help defendants engage in treatment and counseling, as well as partners with local Veterans Affairs offices to ensure that participants receive proper benefits.

Admission Into Veterans Court

Tennessee's six Veterans Treatment Courts are located in Blount, Davidson, Knox, Montgomery, Shelby and Williamson Counties. Although each operates a little differently, the process of connecting Veterans with the program is similar. Once someone is bonded, they are asked if they served in the military. If they answer yes, they are flagged and sent to the admissions director. When that Veteran is appointed a lawyer, the lawyer can contact the court if there is interest in joining the program. The Veteran's lawyer fills out the admissions request, then the court accesses the Veteran's discharge papers. If everything checks out, a request to enter Veterans Court is sent to the state prosecutor for review. The state prosecutor contacts the victim(s) to ask how they feel about this Veteran participating in Veterans Treatment Court. A victim's response does not control the outcome, but can be persuasive. Once approved, the Veteran is given a contract to sign.

A Focused Approach

The focus of Veterans Treatment Court is treatment and rehabilitation, not punishment.

Veterans Treatment Court is a hands-on program that involves clinical treatment, as well as Moral Recognition Treatment (MRT). MRT is an evidence-based treatment curriculum that involves weekly workbook assignments. Williamson County Case Manager Tracy McKinney assists Veterans with MRT every week, as well as being available whenever the need arises.

Housing Crisis A Widespread Problem

Another way the Veterans Treatment Court staff wishes they could help is with housing. A lack of suitable housing for Veterans is the biggest challenge for the majority of Tennessee's Veterans Courts. Shelby County VTC Director Easter is currently working to obtain funding for housing for female Veterans, a population he said is vastly underserved.

Personal and Program Success

Despite the funding struggles, it is rewarding when a Veteran puts in the hard work and graduates from the program a changed person. Veterans Treatment Court staff often hear from these Veterans long after they leave the program. What they hear often reminds them that their work matters.

Request your military service records (including DD214)

Types of information you can get:

You can request your military service records to get information like this:

- Your character of discharge (from your DD214 or other separation documents)
- Your duty stations and assignments
- Your medals and decorations (awards)
- Your qualifications, licenses, and certificates

How to request your records from the National Archives:

- You can request records from the National Archives online, by mail, or by fax.
- **Note:** If you're submitting an application for VA benefits, we'll request your DD214 for you when we receive your application. You don't need to do this yourself through the National Archives.

State Retired ID Cards

After completing 20 years of **creditable service** (M-day) in the National Guard, you will receive a **20-year Notification of Eligibility for Retired Pay** letter. This letter will qualify you for retirement pay and Tricare Standard insurance on the day you turn 60 years old. Once pay activates, you will receive it every month (direct deposit) for the rest of your life. However, **obtaining retirement pay is not an automatic process** – you must submit a request along with supporting documents to receive your retirement pay.

For Retiring Soldiers:

Soldiers are encouraged to apply for their retirement pay, 12 months from retirement. Some Soldiers may even qualify for an Early-Age Drop retirement under the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2008.. Soldiers can submit the retirement packet themselves, or contact the Retirement Services Officer (RSO) who will submit the packet for you to Human Resource Command (HRC).

The following documents are needed:

- DD Form 2656 (Data for Payment or Retired Personnel)
- DD Form 108 (Application for Retired Pay Benefits)
- NGB 23 D (Notification of Eligibility for Retired Pay (20-year letter) or 15 year letter)
- DD Form 1883 or DD Form 2656-5 (Survivor's Benefits Election Certificate)
- Separation Order from the National Guard
- NGB 23 (Retirement Points History Statement) (must show final date in the Guard)
- NGB 22 (Report of Separation and Record of Service)

TN Military and Veteran State Tax Benefits

Tennessee Income Taxes: Tennessee does not have a general state income tax. Residents do not have to file an individual state income tax return.

Distributions received from the Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) are not taxed.

Applications can be made through the local County Trustee or City Collecting Official:

Tennessee Disabled Veteran and Surviving Spouse State Property Tax Benefits:

Disabled Veterans and their Surviving Spouse may qualify for a rebate of exemption of taxes on a portion of the value of their property. The Veteran or Surviving Spouse must own and use the property as their primary residence. The maximum market value on which tax relief is calculated is \$175,000.

Who is eligible for Tennessee Disabled Veteran and Surviving Spouse State Property Tax Benefits?

To be eligible for property tax relief applicants must meet the following requirements:

For Disabled Veteran:

To be eligible a disabled veteran must have served in the U.S. Armed Forces and received a discharge other than dishonorable and have a service connected disability rating from the VA that meets one of the following requirements:

Disability rating due to:

- Paraplegia, or
- Permanent paralysis of both legs and lower part of the body from traumatic injury or disease to the spinal cord or brain, or
- Loss, or loss of the use, two or more limbs, or
- Legal blindness, or
- Total and permanent disability, or
- 100% total and permanent disability rating due to being a prisoner of war.

For Surviving Spouse or a Disabled Veteran:

This benefit transfers to the un-remarried Surviving Spouse of a disabled veteran who was eligible for property tax relief. The Surviving Spouse must solely or jointly own the property and must use it as their home.

TN Helping Heroes Education Grants for Veterans

The Helping Heroes Grant offers a \$1,000 grant per semester to eligible Veterans who enroll in 12 or more semester hours, and a \$500 grant per semester for 6 to 11 semester hours. Veterans enrolled in less than six semester hours are not eligible for a grant. All grants are paid at the end of a semester.

Veterans are eligible to receive a grant for eight full semesters (6-11 semester hours is considered a half semester) or until they earn a bachelor's degree, whichever comes first. Helping Heroes Grants are awarded on a first-come first-served basis. Veterans must receive a passing final grade in all classes at the end of the semester to be eligible for a grant.

Who is eligible for the Tennessee Helping Heroes Education Grant for Veterans?

To be eligible for a Helping Heroes Grant Veterans must meet the following requirements:

Current Service member or honorably discharged Veteran who is serving or served on active duty as a member of an active or reserve component of the U.S. Armed Forces

Tennessee resident for one year prior to application

Was awarded one of the following, on or after September 11, 2001:

Iraq Campaign Medal

Afghanistan Campaign Medal

Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal

Enrolled at a participating two or four-year postsecondary institution

Has not earned a bachelor's degree

Not in default on a federal or state educational loan

Not owe a refund on a federal or state student financial aid program

In compliance with federal drug-free rules for receiving financial assistance

Not incarcerated

Students are not required to meet any academic standard at the time of enrollment

To remain eligible for grants, Veterans must meet satisfactory academic progress requirements of the institution they are attending.

Helping Heroes Grants must be applied for each academic year using the [Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation Online Application](#). The application deadlines are:

September 1 (or the following business day) for fall enrollment

February 1 (or the following business day) for spring enrollment

May 1 (or the following business day) for summer enrollment

DOCUMENTATION:

Proof of both Tennessee residency along with proof of veterans' status should be secured. When proof of eligibility is verified, notation of the form of documentation, i.e. DD214, VA benefit card, TN drivers' license, etc, should be entered on the receipt, folio, or registration screen applicable to the operation.

DISCOUNTED RATES:

A Tennessee veterans' discount for camping within our state parks is available during the off-season, (December 1 through February 28/29). The discount is 50% off of our standard nightly base rates depending on the type of site chosen. Premium sites excluded. This camping discount is available to Tennessee residents showing proof of prior military duty.

A 50% discount off of camping and overnight cabin lodging fees will be extended to Tennessee resident veterans with a 100% total service-connected disability.

All veteran discounts require proof of prior military duty. Acceptable ID's for proof of eligibility include a VA benefits card, retired military ID, or a DD-214. These are in addition to proof of residency which would simply be a TN driver's license or vehicle registered in Tennessee.

HUNTING AND FISHING LISCENCE:

Authorizes issuance of a sport fishing and hunting license with a one-time \$10 fee to residents of Tennessee who are 100% permanent and totally disabled from service connected cause, or by reason of service in any war are 30% or more disabled.

Authorizes honorably discharged veterans to have language or a symbol indicating their military service placed on their driver license; requires the Department of Veterans Services, in consultation with the department of safety, to develop appropriate language or military symbol.

County Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax:

Any disabled veteran who has a 100 percent permanent, total disability from a service connected cause, or any former prisoner-of-war, as determined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, shall be exempt from the motor vehicle privilege tax upon submission of evidence of such disability to the officer in the county charged with the responsibility for collecting such tax.

Highways for Heroes Program:

Commercial Driver License Program for Service Members and Veterans

Under legislation passed by the General Assembly in 2013, the road skills test may be waived for qualified military personnel applying for a Tennessee Commercial Driver License (CDL). Applicants, however, are required to pass the applicable CDL knowledge test. Qualified active duty military personnel who held a military operator's permit for the past two years are eligible for the basic road skills test waiver. This applied to current National Guard and military Reserve Personnel as well as Veterans who have been discharged within the last year.

Moto Vehicle Sales for Members of the Armed Forces:

As provided in [Public Chapter 842, Tenn. Code Ann. Section 67-6-303\(a\)\(1\)](#) exempts from sales tax the sale of motor vehicles in this state to members of the Tennessee National Guard or reserve members of a uniformed service of the United States who are called into active military service and who are stationed outside the United States during hostilities in which such person is actually engaged in combat.

State Disabled Veteran Plate Program



Available to: Veterans of the United States military with a disability incurred in or aggravated by active military services of the United States, which falls within the parameters outlined in [Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-4-256](#).

Documentation Required: A letter from the federal Department of Veteran Affairs verifying that the veteran was rated permanent and totally disabled with an effective date. The precise language may vary slightly, but a permanent and total rating always means that the veteran is being compensated at 100 percent.

Cost: None for first plate. Second plate - \$26.50 annual fee (initial fee is \$28.15). Subsequent plates - \$26.50 annual fee (initial fee is \$29.80).




Flags for Military Burial

A United States flag is provided, at no cost, to drape the casket or accompany the urn of a deceased Veteran who served honorably in the U.S. Armed Forces.

Who Is Eligible to Receive the Burial Flag?

Generally, the flag is given to the next-of-kin, as a keepsake, after its use during the funeral service. When there is no next-of-kin, VA will furnish the flag to a friend making request for it. For those VA national cemeteries with an Avenue of Flags, families of Veterans buried in these national cemeteries may donate the burial flags of their loved ones to be flown on patriotic holidays.

How Can You Apply?

You may apply for the flag by completing [VA Form 27-2008, Application for United States Flag for Burial Purposes](#). U.S. Post Offices are the primary issuing point for burial flags. Generally, the funeral director can help you obtain a flag. Call and confirm with the post office in advance. Not all local post offices have burial flags on hand but they should be able to direct you to the closest issuing post office. Regional VA Offices can also help identify local issuing points.

Can a Burial Flag Be Replaced?

The law allows us to issue one flag for a Veteran's funeral. We cannot replace it if it is lost, destroyed, or stolen. However, some Veterans' organizations or other community groups may be able to help you get another flag.

Flags for Military Burial

Tennessee Veterans: If you serve in the TN National Guard for 1 year or more, and are active, honorably discharged or retired at the time of your death, your family is authorized to receive a State of TN flag.

2023 Tennessee Code Title 58 - MILITARY AFFAIRS, EMERGENCIES AND CIVIL DEFENSE (§§ 58-1-101 — 58-9-105) Chapter 1 - MILITARY FORCES (§§ 58-1-101 — 58-1-706) Part 2 - NATIONAL GUARD (§§ 58-1-201 — 58-1-236) Section 58-1-236 - Burial flag for family of deceased member of national guard Universal Citation: TN Code § 58-1-236 (2023)

(a) The adjutant general shall present to the family of each eligible, deceased member of the national guard a Tennessee state flag, appropriate for use as a burial flag, upon application of a member of the family of the deceased guard member.

(b) The adjutant general shall prepare an application form to be used to determine the eligibility of the deceased for the burial flag and shall furnish the form to the senior full-time employee in each armory.

(c) The family of any individual who serves at least one (1) year in the national guard and who at the time of death is an active, honorably discharged, or retired member of the national guard is eligible to receive a burial flag.

(d) The adjutant general may, in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, compiled in title 4, chapter 5, promulgate rules to implement this section. (e) The adjutant general shall obtain flags from the federal government when available. If flags from the federal government are not available, the adjutant general shall purchase the flags from funds appropriated to the military department.

How to fold a U.S. Flag

“On behalf of a grateful nation...”

To properly fold the flag follow these directions:



1 To begin, with one person at either end, hold the flag waist high so that its surface is parallel to the ground.



2 Fold the lower half of the stripe section lengthwise over the field of stars, holding the bottom and top edges securely.



3 Fold the flag again lengthwise, now with the blue field on the outside.



4 Make a triangular fold by bringing the striped corner of the folded edge to meet the open (top) edge of the flag.



5 Turn the outer (end) point inward, parallel to the open edge, to form a second triangle.



6 Continue the triangular folding until the entire length of the flag is folded in this manner.



7 When the flag is completely folded, only a triangular blue field of stars should be visible. If a hem protrudes beyond the blue field, it should be neatly tucked inside the folds of the flag so it does not show.

The folded flag is then presented to the next of kin.

Unclaimed Veteran Remains



Tennessee Department of Veterans Services Unclaimed Veteran Remains

Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

Created April, 2013



1. Objective:

This formal Tennessee Department of Veterans Services (TDVS) Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) has been created to give consistent guidance to TDVS cemetery personnel and Tennessee funeral directors in regards to providing unclaimed Veteran remains with a dignified and proper burial at the State Veterans Cemeteries.

Definition:

Veteran is defined in the 38 Code of Federal Regulations 3.1 as a person who served in the active military, naval, or air service and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.

2. Process:

In the event a Tennessee funeral director discovers he/she is in possession of the remains of Veteran, they may contact TDVS for assistance to inter the remains in the nearest Tennessee State Veterans Cemetery or National Veterans Cemetery.

Public Chapter No. 823 T.C.A. 62-5-703 (12) allows the funeral director to assume the right of disposition in cases where next of kin cannot be located or in cases where next of kin forfeits their right of disposition.

(12) In the absence of any person listed in subdivisions (1)-(11), any other person willing to assume the responsibilities to act and arrange the final disposition of the decedent's remains, including the funeral director with custody of the body, after attesting in writing that a good faith effort has been made to no avail to contact the individuals listed in subdivisions (1)-(11).

T.C.A 62-5-704 (2) also provides a timeline for notification as it pertains to disposition of the unclaimed remains. In summary, the funeral director may exercise the right of disposition if the next of kin is not willing to claim the Veteran's remains within three (3) days of notification or no next of kin is located within one week or seven (7) days of the Veteran's death.

(2) Any person who does not exercise the right of disposition within seventy two (72) hours of notification of the decedent's death or within one hundred and sixty eight (168) hours of the decedent's death, whichever is earlier.

Funeral directors are required to keep and maintain written records of attempts to contact next of kin and results of each attempt. Upon establishing a partnership with TDVS, the funeral director will provide a copy of the written records to be kept and maintained at the pertinent State Veterans Cemetery.

Funeral directors must also provide evidence of Veteran status to the nearest TDVS Cemetery Director for confirmation of eligibility for burial in the nearest State Veterans Cemetery.

Unclaimed Veteran Remains



Funeral directors may coordinate with TDVS cemetery personnel in regards to contacting the Honor Guard, chaplains and other Veterans Service Organizations or non-profit organizations to support military honors for services at the State Veterans Cemeteries.

In order to maintain the appropriate chain of custody of the unclaimed Veteran remains, the funeral director is responsible for transportation of the remains to the State Veterans Cemetery or National Veterans Cemetery.

3. TDVS

Cemetery Directors will file appropriate claims with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for appropriate grave markers or placards for columbarium.

Funeral directors must file for reimbursement for caskets and urns with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs in accordance with Title 38 of the United States Code Section 101 (f), (1) and (2) which states;

'(f) The Secretary may furnish a casket or urn, of such quality as the Secretary considers appropriate for a dignified burial, for burial in a national cemetery of a deceased veteran in any case in which the Secretary (1) is unable to identify the veteran's next of kin, if any; and (2) determines that sufficient resources for the furnishing

In accordance with Title 38 of the United States Code Section 103 §2414 (a), (1), (2), (b), (1), (2), funeral directors and TDVS Cemetery Directors are required to notify the United States Department of Veterans Affairs with regards to the unclaimed Veteran and the status of next of kin.

(a) REQUIRED INFORMATION. - With respect to each deceased veteran described in subsection (b) who is transported to a national cemetery for burial, the Secretary shall ensure that the local medical examiner, funeral director, county service group, or other entity responsible for the body of the deceased veteran before such transportation submits to the Secretary the following information:

- (1) Whether the deceased veteran was cremated.
- (2) The steps taken to ensure that the deceased veteran has no next of kin.

(b) DECEASED VETERAN DESCRIBED. - A deceased veteran described in this subsection is a deceased veteran (1) with respect to whom the Secretary determines that there is no next of kin or other person claiming the body of the deceased veteran; and (2) who does not have sufficient resources for the furnishing of a casket or urn for the burial of the deceased veteran in a national cemetery, as determined by the Secretary."

TENNESSEE WARS COMMISSION



The Tennessee General Assembly enacted legislation in April 1994 creating the Tennessee Wars Commission (TWC), which is administratively attached to the Tennessee Historical Commission (THC). The duties of the Wars Commission are performed by one staff member, the Director of Programs. The Wars Commission's mission of preserving and interpreting Tennessee's military heritage is realized in part by funding grants, through civic and governmental engagement, education and interpretation, and by way of conservation efforts.

The Wars Commission has been charged with coordinating planning efforts, the preservation and promotion of structures, buildings, sites, and battlefields in Tennessee from the French and Indian War (1754-1763), American Revolutionary War (1775-1783), War of 1812 (1812-1815), Mexican-American War (1846-1848) through the Civil War (1861-1865) era. The Wars Commission is also charged with acquiring or providing funds for the acquisition of battlefields, cemeteries, Underground Railroad sites, and other properties associated with the aforementioned conflicts.

Since its establishment 30 years ago, the Wars Commission has helped acquire and permanently protect over 8,000 acres of historic properties including the Camp Blount Historic Site, a War of 1812 muster site that gave Tennessee the moniker the "Volunteer State." With the creation of the Civil War Sites Preservation Grant Fund (CWS SPF) in 2013, 1,100 acres of hallowed Civil War ground have been perpetually preserved. To date, the Wars Commission Grant Fund (WCGF) has supported well over one hundred different projects that preserve, protect, and interpret Tennessee's military heritage. These projects have included funding:

- archaeological and geophysical surveys of Battle of Nashville sites including the largest inland stone fortification, Fort Negley.
- the creation of the *State-Wide Battlefield Preservation Plan* by the Tennessee Civil War Preservation Association that aims to realize additional opportunities for Civil War battlefield preservation.
- the development of the *Road to Freedom Brochure and Mobile Application*, a heritage tourism resource highlighting the African American experience during the Civil War focusing on compelling stories of strife, growth, and community by surfacing concepts of empowerment and self-emancipation.

Tennessee Fallen Hero Medal

The Tennessee Fallen Heroes Medal may be awarded on behalf of the people of the state of Tennessee to an individual serving on active duty who has been killed in action, while:

- (1) Engaged in an action against an enemy of the United States;
- (2) Engaged in military support operations involving conflict with an opposing foreign force;
- (3) Serving with friendly foreign forces engaged in an armed conflict against an opposing armed force in which the United States is not a belligerent party; or
- (4) Serving in a combat zone as designated by presidential order.

The recipient's name will be entered on the case of the Tennessee Fallen Heroes Medal. Individuals eligible to receive the Tennessee Fallen Heroes Medal include all active duty military who are legal residents of the state of Tennessee. The Tennessee Fallen Heroes Medal will be awarded solely by the governor or the governor's designee to the immediate survivor of the recipient. This law went into effect July 1, 2011 and is not retroactive.




